WHO WE SERVED

22 participants (8 girls, 10 boys ages 6-12 years old; 4 teachers) represented 6 schools Mayfield Primary, Epping Forest Primary, Pedro Plains Primary, St. Mary's Primay, Munro Prep and The Hampton School

WHAT WE DID

- Hosted a 2 week virtual camp July 27-August 7, 2020
- Designed an Arts & Language 2 week Instructional Camp Guide (*with professional support from an English Language Arts Teacher & Edna Manley College Lecturer*)
- Provided resource kits for video instruction, group calls and chats
- Daily video calls and check-ins with a Camp Coordinator which supported lessons about Jamaican basketry weaving techniques and traditional building methods
- Guided Campers' individual art, poetry & short story projects for Competition
- Hosted a Prize Giving Ceremony

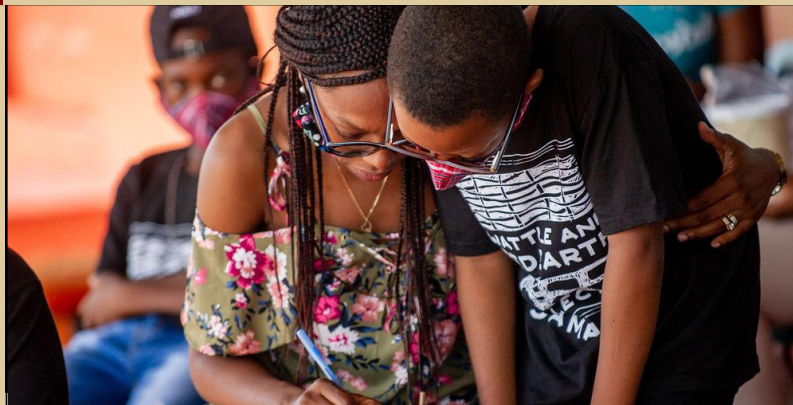
